General Information

Dinner: As we are having an evening rehearsal and recital, dinner will be available at both rehearsal and recital for approximately \$7 per plate provided by Carrabbas. They will have child-friendly options such as ravioli as well as adult-friendly like chicken marsala. We will have tables and chairs set up in the lobby for you to have a comfortable dinner with your family.

Show tickets: We are giving you the option of reserving your seats ahead of time and seating yourself when you drop off your child an hour before the show begins. Recital tickets are available for purchase on Tututix.com/lisadanceandexercise or by calling Tututix at 855-222-2849. As you know, you receive one ticket that is included in your recital fee. Extra tickets are available through the same site at \$15 each. Backstage volunteers who sign up on the volunteer sheet in the studio lobby ABOVE the cut-off line do not need a ticket. To get the included ticket, you will put in a ticket code on the Tututix.com website when you select your included recital tickets. The ticket code is the first initial and last name as one word of your oldest child that is in our dance classes. For example, my code for my oldest child, William Lee, would be Wlee. The code/name we use is what you put on your recital form. If you have multiple kids in our classes or are taking multiple classes, you may have more than two tickets available with your code. Contact Alyssa if you are unsure at 561-309-3171. **Tickets will be available starting Sunday, October 29 at 3pm for those who have paid their class and recital fees in full, and no tickets will be available before that time.** You should select your included recital ticket *and* all of your \$15 per seat tickets for all your family and friends at the same time if you want to sit with the friends and family members you invite to the recital. Any tickets purchased separately may not be seated together. If you are a sponsor, you have a special code that Alyssa will give you. If you have any questions about tickets, please contact Alyssa directly at 561-309-3171 *before* October 22 to ensure you are able to get your questions answered in time to reserve them when they're first available. If you have problems while booking your tickets, it is best to contact Tututix directly at 855-222-2849 to get the fastest help. Tickets are first come first served with regard to the seating chart on the website. We cannot guarantee any tickets will be available the day of the show.

Pictures: In the past, we have had a professional photographer will be take pictures of your child his his or her costume before the show. Please let your child's teacher know if you are interested in this and we will arrange it if there is enough interest.

Video: A professional video of the show will be taken. The DVD will be available for sale after the show for \$25. Please look for the sign-up page on the studio wall and make sure you sign up ahead of time and pay the \$25 if you are interested. Those who do not pre-pay are not guaranteed a DVD.

Volunteers: We are in need of many volunteers for the show. There is a sign-up sheet on the studio wall (in the next few weeks) if you're interested. Volunteers will be supervising the children backstage, taking children to the bathroom and participating in getting children ready for the finale and their numbers. They will also help with comforting any upset children and giving children snacks and toys. Volunteers must show up promptly at 4:30pm for theatre rehearsal and 3pm for recital **dressed in all black** in the rare event they are needed to be on stage with the children. Volunteers will be able to view their children's dances from behind a tape line behind the curtains onstage.

Fees: All current class and costume fees **MUST BE PAID IN FULL** before the show. If you currently have an outstanding balance, payment will be required in order for your child to be able to participate in the rehearsal and the show. If not paid before December 5, your child **WILL NOT** participate in the December recital.

Personal belongings: Please put your child's **FIRST AND LAST** name on ALL their belongings (including each of their shoes) in a gallon Ziploc bag. Children with more than two costume changes are allowed to bring a bag to hold all of their costumes but their name HAS to be on the outside of the bag and their costumes must be separated into Ziploc or garment bags inside of the bag as well. Please keep all outdoor shoes, clothes, jewelry, and other items with a parent or guardian. We cannot guarantee the return of personal or unlabeled items left at the show.

Show Etiquette

- Please do not arrive late to the show. We will start **ON TIME**.
- Please do not use flash photography or videotaping using the flash, during the show as it will distract our dancers and some have had sore eyes afterward from flash. You may take pictures and video, just please once again do not use the flash. The stage will provide plenty of lighting.
- Please silence your cell phones before the performance begins.
- No food or drinks are allowed in this theatre although refreshments including soda, water and snacks will be available for purchase and consumption in the lobby.

Make Up Classes and Dress Rehearsals

Looking ahead, we will not be having class on Halloween all day or for Thanksgiving weekend (November 22-26) as well as Monday evening, December 11 during our rehearsal. These are not classes you have paid for so no need to make them up. However, if you feel your child needs extra practice, you can drop in to any of our classes with availability for \$15.

If at all possible, your child should make up any missed classes with *their* teacher. This is because different teachers are teaching different dances and for ages 3-4 and 4-7, we have A and B groups learning one dance they will do together and one dance they will do separately. **IF YOU KNOW YOU WILL MISS A CLASS, YOU CAN MAKE IT UP IN ADVANCE TO MISSING IT, AND WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO DO THIS.**

For Palm Beach Gardens make up classes, please contact Lisa directly 561-317-5738.

Creative Movement and Ballet classes can make up any Tuesday at 10:30am, Thursday at 11:30am or Saturday at 4pm without calling ahead. Please do not make up in the evening or Saturday morning classes if you are a weekday morning student.

3 Year Old Ballet and Tap with Miss Lisa or Miss Malisha can make up Mondays at 11:30am and Thursdays at 10:30am without calling ahead

3 Year Old Ballet and Tap with Miss Alyssa can be made up Wednesdays at 6pm or Saturdays at 11:30am, but these must be scheduled ahead of time with Lisa or Alyssa as these classes are full 561-317-5738. Texting is best.

4-7 Year Old Ballet and Tap with Miss Lisa can be made up Mondays at 5 or 6pm without scheduling ahead. It is okay to take two classes back to back.

4-7 Year Old Ballet and Tap with Miss Shannon or Miss Alyssa can be made up any Wednesday at 7pm or Saturday at 2pm without scheduling ahead.

Intermediate classes should speak with Miss Shannon in class. Modern classes should speak with Miss Kylissa in class.

This studio rehearsal will give the kids a chance to rehearse the dances they will all do together and provide a chance for teachers to iron out any kinks before the theatre rehearsal to ensure it runs smoothly. Modern, Intermediate and Hip Hop classes do not need to attend the studio rehearsal. Please arrive 5 minutes early as practices will start exactly on time. Please DO NOT bring your child in their recital outfit as we do not want extra wear and tear on them or to risk getting them dirty unnecessarily. Children do, however, need dancewear and their normal class shoes.

Please arrive on time and drop off your child to the right side of the building. It will be marked "Student drop-off." After you drop off your child, please come in through the front door and take a seat in the theatre. Rehearsal will be from 5pm to 8pm, and not everyone is required to stay the entire time. We will run the entire show from start to finish, and children may leave as soon as all their dances are finished (We will announce this and have a proper dismissal. Please do not just come get your child for safety reasons.) Snacks are allowed to be brought with your children, but there will be regular items provided back stage for them as well as a \$7 dinner provided by Carrabbas which they can eat with you. Students who do not participate in the rehearsal will not participate in the show unless pre-arranged with Miss Lisa, Miss Alyssa or Miss Shannon in advance and for a valid reason. Students should come dressed **in their costume** with hair and makeup done. (Makeup is optional for everyone under the age of 8 and is left up to the parent's discretion.) Please bring all items necessary for costume changes in a gallon Ziploc bag with the child's first and last name on the bag in clear print. Their names should be on the inside of each of their shoes and costume items.

Please arrive on time and drop off your child to the right side of the building through the same door as the rehearsal day. It will be marked, "Student drop off." After you drop off your child please come in through the front door of the theatre. Students should come dressed in their costume for their first number with hair and makeup done. (Makeup is optional for everyone under the age of 8 and is left up to the parent's discretion.) Please bring all items necessary for costume changes with the child in a gallon Ziploc bag with the child's first and last name on the bag in clear print as well on all of their costume pieces and belongings. Children will be released at the end of the show with the exception of Creative Movement and Ballet which will be released at intermission. Children will be required to stay backstage during the show, and no early releases will be allowed. For the children's safety, parents will **NOT** be allowed backstage at any time before, during or after the show, except for parent volunteers or unless told otherwise by Miss Lisa.
