General Information

Show Tickets: WE ARE USING A NEWTICKET COMPANY THIS RECITAL because they charge YOU less in fees. Sales Start Sunday, <u>May 4th at 3:00pm</u> Visit https://www.danceticketing.com/32368. Tickets are available for those who have paid their class session and recital fees in full. Tickets cost \$35 each and are required for entry. Children sitting on laps do not need tickets. Tickets will be available ONLINE ONLY through the day of recital but there is a \$5 increase on ticket prices from May 25 on days.

If you have any questions about tickets, please contact Brittany via text 360-722-1179. If you have questions regarding recital and ticket *policies*; please contact Lisa at 561-317-5738. It is recommended that you purchase your tickets as soon as you can as we have sold out before. We cannot guarantee any tickets will be available for purchase on the day of the show. Backstage volunteers that have signed up on the volunteer sheet in the studio lobby ABOVE the cut-off line, do NOT need a ticket.

<u>Pictures</u>: We are using Monica Griffith Photography to take individual pictures of your child(ren) in their costumes before the recital here at the dance studio. We used her for our last 6 recitals' pictures, and I have never seen more beautiful children's dance photography! You can check out her work at <u>wwwMonicaGriffith.com</u> You can sign up for these pictures on our lobby wall in a few weeks. Please bring your children with their hair and makeup (optional) done and ALL their costumes. Pictures must be paid for in advance. There is an extra fee for pictures, and they are optional.

<u>Videor</u> A professional video of the show will be taken. The link to download will be emailed to you about 6 weeks after the show Please look for the sign-up page on the studio wall and make sure you sign up ahead of time and pay the \$35 if you are interested. Those who do not pre-pay will not receive a copy. Please make your payment ONLY with cash or check in the black box in the lobby and make a note that it is for your recital video with your name, dancer's name and phone number. Payment should not be given to your teacher. If enough people sign up, we may provide a flash drive as well.

<u>Food:</u> We will have food and drink purchases at the recital the day of the show only in the concession area. Food will include bagged chips and pizza. No food or drinks are allowed in the theater itself – they may be consumed in the lobby.

<u>Volunteers</u> We are in need of many volunteers for the show. There will be a sign-up sheet on the studio wall (in the next few weeks) if you're interested. Volunteers will be supervising the children (not just your own child) backstage, taking children to the bathroom and participating in getting children ready for the finale and their numbers. They will also help with comforting any upset children and giving children snacks and toys. Volunteers must show up promptly at 1pm for theatre rehearsal AND 1pm for recital dressed in all black in the rare event they are needed to be on stage with the children. If you cannot come to both the dress rehearsal and the recital, please do not volunteer. Volunteers must also bring a snack or drink to share with the kids during recital AND rehearsal (please bring enough for 20 children). We also recommend that volunteers bring a blanket to sit on, a fan and if they want toys (some will be provided), coloring books and crayons. ND MARKERS are allowed. There will be a lead volunteer – Stephanie Beras in the 3–4 Ballet & Tap and Elizabeth Paro in the 5–9 Ballet & Tap, Gymnastics and Intermediate 3 Ballet & Tap. They speak and act with Lisa's authority and will take names if people directly do things to endanger the children or make the backstage environment an uncomfortable place such as leaving early or not sharing space. Volunteers will be able to view their children's dances from behind the curtains onstage. While volunteers are

directly in charge of the children in the class their child normally attends, they are expected to help any other child or parent that needs help if theirs are not in immediate need. With the exception of Oreative Movement, Hp Hop toddlers and 3-9 Ballet & Tap, which will dismiss at intermission BUT NOT BEFORE, DO NOT allow parents to pick up their children early. This is a huge safety risk, and police will be positioned outside the exits in the dance rooms to make sure they are not being used.

<u>Fees</u>: All current class and recital/costume fees <u>MUST BE PAD IN FUL</u> before the show. If you currently have an outstanding balance, payment will be required in order for your child to be able to participate in the rehearsal and the show If not paid before May 15, 2025 your child <u>WILL NOT</u> participate in the recital.

<u>Personal belongings</u>: Please put your child's <u>FIRST AND LAST</u> name on ALL their belongings (including each of their shoes) in a gallon Ziploc bag or garment bag. Children with more than two costume changes are allowed to bring a bag to hold all of their costumes but their name HAS to be on the outside of the bag and their costumes must be separated into Ziploc or garment bags inside of the bag as well. Please keep all outdoor shoes, clothes, jewelry, and other items with a parent or guardian. We cannot guarantee the return of personal or unlabeled items left at the show

Show Etiquette

Please do not arrive late to the show We will start ONTIME

Please do not use flash photography or videotaping with a light during the show as it will distract our dancers, and some have had sore eyes afterward from flash. You may take pictures and video, just please once again do not use the flash. The stage will provide plenty of lighting.

Please silence your cell phones before the performance begins.

No food or drinks are allowed in this theatre although refreshments including soda, water and snacks will be available for purchase and consumption in the lobby.

Make Up Classes and Dress Rehearsals

This studio rehearsal will give the kids a chance to rehearse the dances they will all do together and provide a chance for teachers to iron out any kinks before the theatre rehearsal to ensure it runs smoothly. Contemporary, Musical Theatre, Modern, Jazz/Acro, Intermediate Ballet and Tap and most Hp Hbp classes do not need to attend the studio rehearsal. Please arrive 5 minutes early as practices will start on time. Please DONDT bring your child in their recital outfit as we do not want extra wear and tear on them or to risk getting them dirty unnecessarily. Children do, however, need dancewear and their normal class shoes.

Mandatory Dress Rehearsal

Please arrive on time and follow the signs to drop off your child in the theater rooms. Find the door labeled for your child's class. After you drop off your child, please come in through the front door and take a seat in the theatre. Rehearsal will be from 2pm to 7ish, and not everyone is required to stay the entire time. We will run the entire show from start to finish and ALL CLASSES EXCEPT FOR TODDLER HP HOP, CREATIVE MOVEMENT AND BALLET AND TAP AGES 3-9 MUST WAIT FOR AND PARTICIPATE INFINALE OURTSY. We will dismiss after this. Please do not just come get your child for safety reasons. Snacks are allowed to be brought with your children, but there will be regular items provided back stage for them. No nut, dairy or strawberry snacks please as we have children with allergies to these things. Students who do not participate in the rehearsal will not participate in the show unless pre-arranged with Lisa in advance and for a valid reason. Students should come dressed in their costume (ballet first, if applicable) with hair and makeup done. (Makeup is optional for everyone and is left up the parent's discretion.) Please bring all items necessary for costumes changes in a gallon Ziploc bag with the child's first and last name on the bag in clear print. Their names should be on the inside of each of their shoes and costume items.

Please arrive on time and follow the signs to drop off your child in the theater rooms. Find the door labeled for your child's class. After you drop off your child, please come in through the front door and take a seat in the theatre. Students should come dressed in their costume for their first number with hair and makeup done. (Makeup is optional for everyone and is left up the parent's discretion.) Please bring all items necessary for costumes changes with the child in a gallon Ziploc bag with the child's first and last name on the bag in clear print as well on all of their costume pieces and belongings. <u>Children will be released at the end of the show with the exception of Oreative Movement and Ballet which will be released at intermission.</u> <u>Children will be released at the end of the show with the show and no early releases will be allowed</u>. For the children's safety, parents will <u>NOT</u> be allowed backstage at any time before, during or after the show except for parent volunteers or unless told otherwise by Mss Lisa.
